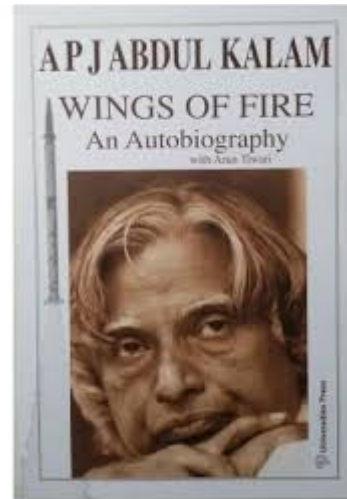
Mother To Son

ATOMIC BOMB

During World War II the United States used an unprecedented \$2 billion to fund an ultra-secret research and development programme, the outcomes of which would alter the relationships of nations forever

The motivation was simple. Scientists fleeing the Nazi regime had revealed that a research programme in Germany had confirmed the theoretical viability of atomic bombs. Albert Einstein and others wrote to President Franklin D Roosevelt (FDR) warning of the need for atomic research. By 1941 FDR had authorised formal, co-ordinated scientific research into such a device. Among those whose efforts would ultimately unleash the power of the atom was Robert Oppenheimer (1904-1967), who was appointed the project's scientific director in 1942. Under his direction the



famous laboratories at Los Alamos would be constructed and the scientific team assembled.

An atomic bomb initiates a nuclear chain reaction, thereby releasing truly vast amounts of energy. Initial problem was the production of enough “enriched” uranium to sustain such a reaction. Instrumental in the solution was Italian physicist Enrico Fermi in a former squash court under Chicago University, he and other scientists created the first ever controlled, self-sustaining nuclear explosion, which Oppenheimer called “Trinity”, at Alamogordo, New Mexico, on July 16, 1945.

Little Boy

Little boy was the codename for the atomic bomb dropped on the Japanese city of Hiroshima on 6 August 1945

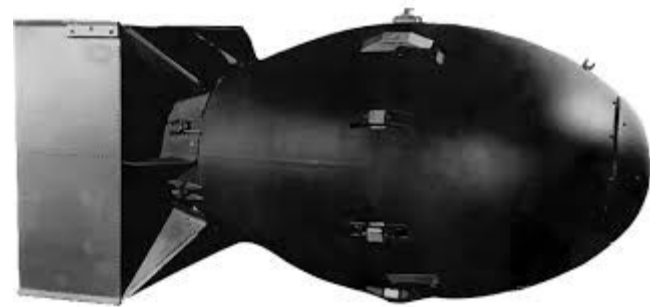


during world war II by the Boeing B-29 Super Fortress Enola Gay, piloted by colonel Paul W Tibbets, Jr commander of the 508th composite group of the US Army Air Forces. It was the first atomic bomb to be used in warfare. The Hiroshima bombing was the second artificial nuclear explosion in history. After the Trinity test and the first uranium based detonation it exploded with an energy of approximately 15 kilotons of TNT (63TJ)

Little Boy was developed by Lieutenant commander Francis Birch's group of captain William S Parsons ordnance division at the Manhattan projects Los Alamos laboratory during world war II

Fat Man

'Fat Man' was the codename for the atomic bomb that was dropped over the Japanese city of Nagasaki by the United States on 9 August 1945. It was the second of the only 2 nuclear weapons ever used in warfare. The first being Little Boy and its detonation marked the third ever man made nuclear explosion in history. It was built by scientists and engineers at Los Alamos laboratory using plutonium from the Hanford site and dropped from the Boeing B-29 superfortress Bockscar for the Fat Man Mission, Bockscar was piloted by Major Charles W Sweeney.



The name Fat Man refers generically to be early design of the bomb, because it had a wide, round shaped. It was also known as the Mark III.

The term child labour is used for employment of children below a certain age, which is considered illegal by law and custom. Child labour is a world phenomena which is considered exploitative and inhuman by many international organisations according to the statistics given by international labour organisation there are about 218 million children between the age of 5 and 17 working

all over the world the figure excludes domestic labour . The most condemned form of child labour is the use of children for military purpose and prostitution.

The fact that vulnerable children are being exploited and forced into work ,which is not fit for their age ,is a human rights concern now . India and other developed and developing countries plagued by the problem of child employment in organised and unorganised sectors .child labour is considered exploitative by the united nation and international labour organisation .The article 32 of the UN speaks about child labour as follows , states parties recognise the right of the child to be protected from economic exploitation and from performing any work that is likely to be hazardous or to interfere with the child's education ,or to be harmful to The child's health or physical ,moral or social

development .Child labour in India is a serious and extensive problem ,with many children under the age of 14 are working in carpet making factories , glass blowing units

and making fireworks with bare little hands. According to the statistics given by government there are 20 million child labour in the country , while other agencies claims that it is 50 million.

Dr. A P J ABDUL KALAM [former president of India]

Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam was born on 15th Oct 1931 in Rameswaram , Tamil Nadu and was 11th President of India from 2002 to 2007 . He was scientist ,mainly at the defence Research Organisation [ISRO].He was intimately involved in Military missile development efforts . He thus can to be known as "Missile Man of India" Kalam was selected has the eleventh president of Indian 2002 . widely refered to as the "Peoples President " , he returned to his Civilian life of education , writing and public service after a single term . He was a recipient of several prestigious awards including the Bharat Ratna . India's highest civilian honour .

His main works are India

2020, Wings of fire , Ignited minds , Inspiring Thought's by A P J Abdul Kalam ;Mission India . My journey : Transforming dreams in to actions While delivering a lecture at Indian Institute of management Shillong , Kalam collapsed and died from an apparent cardiac arrest on 27 July 2015 , aged 83 . His death was mourned across the nation with thousand attending the Funeral Ceremony held in the house town Rameswaram,Where he was buried with full state honours .



ARYABHATA

Aryabhata is the earliest Indian mathematician whom historians know by

name .He lived from 476 to 550 C.E. Little else is known about him . There has been long confusion regarding his identity ;there was another notable Indian mathematician named Aryabhata who flourished sometime between 950 and 1100 C.E . also,the Persian historian Al. Biruni believed that there were two famous Indian mathematicians named Ayabhata who lived around 500 C.E. The subsequent confusion from this blunder ensured until it was disproved in 1926 [Suzuki 219-220].

Prior to Aryabhata , vedic sutras [early Hindu scriptures] had expounded on geometric relationships for the religious purposes such as alter construction and keeping track of calenders . Jain mathematics prior to Aryabhata . In light of this , some Scholars suggest that Aryabhata intented for his Aryabhatiya to be a a commentary on the previous mathematicians and Astronomers or possibly a skeletal outline of his small contributions to the Canon

knowledge , it is written in the sanskrit language , the language of the Aryans – the people from Europe who migrated to India around 1500B.C.E. and melded with the indigenous Indian culture to form Hindu culture [Watson 30] . the styles of the Aryabhatiyam is difficult to describe .



The First World War[1914-18]

One side there were Serbia,Russia,France,England,Japan, Italy,America etc. They were called 'Allies'.On the other side were Germany, Austria, Turkey, Bulgaria, etc. And they were known as 'The Central Powers'.

The First World War came to an end in 1918.

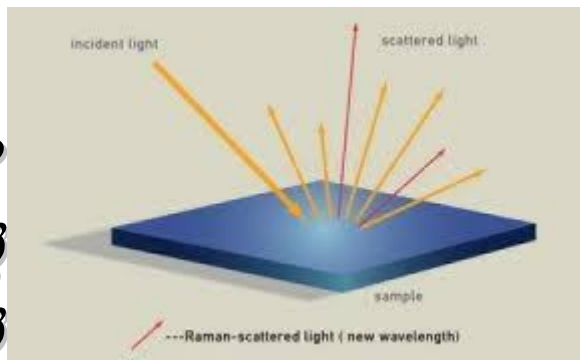

ഭൗതികശാസ്ത്രജ്ഞനാണായിരുന്നു. വർഷങ്ങൾ നീണ്ട അന്വേഷണ പരീക്ഷണങ്ങൾ അദ്ദേഹത്തെ ചില കണ്ടെത്തലുകളിലേക്ക് എത്തിച്ചു. അവയുടെ പ്രാധാന്യം മനസ്സിലാക്കിയ ശാസ്ത്രലോകം ഭൗതികശാസ്ത്ര നോബേൽ നൽകി അദ്ദേഹത്തെ ആദരിക്കുകയും ചെയ്തു. ആ പ്രതിഭ മറ്റാരുമായിരുന്നില്ല, ഇന്ത്യ കണ്ട എക്കാലത്തെയും പ്രഗൽഭനായ ഭൗതിക ശാസ്ത്രജ്ഞൻ സി. വി. രാമൻ.

1917-ൽ രാമൻ സർക്കാർ ജോലി ഉപേക്ഷിച്ച് കൊൽക്കത്ത സർവകലാശാലയിൽ പ്രഫസറായി ചേർന്നു. മുഴുവൻ സമയവും ഗവേഷണങ്ങളിൽ മുഴുകാനും പ്രബന്ധങ്ങൾ തയ്യാറാക്കുവാനും അദ്ദേഹത്തിന് സൗകര്യം ലഭിച്ചു. ലോകത്തിന്റെ പല ഭാഗങ്ങളിലും രാമൻ



പ്രബന്ധങ്ങൾ അവതരിപ്പിച്ചു.

1921-ൽ ലണ്ടനിലേക്ക് യാത്ര ചെയ്യുകയായിരുന്നു രാമൻ. മെഡിറ്ററേനിയൻ കടലിനു മുകളിലൂടെ വിമാനത്തിൽ പോകുകയായിരുന്ന രാമൻ താഴോട്ടു നോക്കി. കടൽ നീലനിറത്തിൽ വെട്ടിത്തിളങ്ങുന്നതായി കണ്ടു. എന്തുകൊണ്ടാണ് കടലിനു നീല നിറമുണ്ടാകുന്നതെന്നു രാമൻ ആലോചിച്ചു തുടങ്ങി. നാട്ടിൽ തിരിച്ചെത്തിയ ഉടനെ രാമൻ ഇതിനെക്കുറിച്ചുള്ള പരീക്ഷണങ്ങൾ ആരംഭിച്ചു.

കടലിന്റെ നീലനിറത്തിന്റെ കാരണം കണ്ടുപിടിക്കാൻ വേണ്ടി തുടങ്ങിയ ആ ഗവേഷണം വലിയ വലിയ വിഷയങ്ങളിലേക്കെത്തി .അവസാനം പ്രകാശം ചിതറിത്തരികുന്നതിനെ സംബന്ധിച്ച സുപ്രധാനമായ ഒരു കണ്ടെത്തലിലേക്ക് അതെത്തിച്ചേർന്നു. രാമൻ ഇഫക്ട് എന്നാണ്

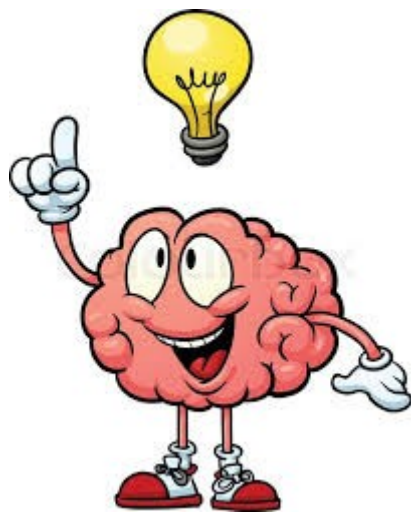
പിന്നീട് ഈ നേട്ടം അറിയപ്പെട്ടത്. ഇതേത്തുടർന്ന് 1930-ൽ ഭൗതികശാസ്ത്ര നോബേൽ അദ്ദേഹത്തിന് ലഭിച്ചു.

1928 ഫെബ്രുവരി 28-ന് രാമൻ ഇഫക്ടിനെക്കുറിച്ചുള്ള പരീക്ഷണങ്ങൾ അദ്ദേഹം പൂർത്തിയാക്കി . ശിഷ്യനായ കെ. എസ്. കൃഷ്ണൻ അദ്ദേഹത്തെ സഹായിക്കാനുണ്ടായിരുന്നു.



തലച്ചോറ് ഒരു വിസ്മയച്ചെപ്പ്

മനുഷ്യനെ വിശിഷ്ടഗുണങ്ങളുള്ള ജീവിയാക്കി മാറ്റുന്ന വിസ്മയച്ചെപ്പാണ് തലച്ചോറ്. ഏകദേശം ഒന്നര കിലോ ഭാരം പതിനായിരം കോടിനൂറോണുകൾ ഓരോ നൂറോണം മറ്റു പതിനായിരം നൂറോണുകളുമായി സിനാപ്സ് വഴി ബന്ധപ്പെട്ടിരിക്കുന്നു. തലച്ചോറിലെ നാഡീകോശങ്ങൾ ചേർത്തുവെച്ചാൽ ഏകദേശം ഒരു ലക്ഷത്തി എൺപതിനായിരം കിലോമീറ്റർ ദൈർഘ്യം വരും. അതായത് ചന്ദ്രനിലേക്കുള്ള ഭൂമിയിന്റെ പകുതി. 25 ലക്ഷം ഗിഗാബൈറ്റ് വിവരങ്ങൾ തലച്ചോറിൽ സംഭരിക്കാനാകും ഏറ്റവും പുതിയ ഐഫോണിന്റെ ക്യാസിറ്റി 512 ഗിഗാബൈറ്റ് ആണെന്ന് ഓർക്കണം.
