Mehran Khan, one of the lucky ones, survived by acting dead.

This was what happened in the deadliest slaughter of innocents in Pakistan when Taliban gunman attacked a military run school on 16 Dec 2014 and killed 141 people-9 of them teachers and the rest students. The shoot-out at the school has shocked all of us. We train ourselves to be greeted with reports about murders, thefts and rapes. However, this incident which took the life of 132 students have shaken us to the core. "A senseless act of unspeakable brutality" as Prime Minister Narendra Modi calls it. It all comes down to a single question. Why? Why is this happening? It seems as though only aim behind this shoot-out was to claim the lives of innocent students. Isn't it humanity any longer a word used to describe humans? Are morals and mercy forgotten words buried under deep layers of history? For Pakistan, the shoot-out is just another event.




NOT A TASTY JAM

Muslim festivals


Each winter, usually sometime in November, about two billion Muslims around the world will celebrate Eid-ul-Fitr, the three-day festival commonly known as "Eid". Eid is commemorated by many different cultural rituals, colours, and festivities in countries across the globe. Each region has specific customs, foods, and traditions associated with this celebration.

The holiday marks the end of Ramadan, the holy month of fasting and is a culmination of the month-long struggle towards a higher spiritual state. Ramadan holds special significance for Muslims, since the Quran, the book of Muslim scripture, was revealed during this month. It is also the time when Muslims fast from sunrise to sunset each day, refraining not only from food and water but also from both material as well as spiritual vices, such as lying, cheating, violence, or theft. The fasting is not only a symbol of sacrifice and purification, but also a measure of self-restraint and a tool for encouraging compassion for the hungry, the poor, and the less fortunate.

Charity and service are especially emphasized during Ramadan, and Muslims are required to donate food and a percentage of their savings to the under-served and neglected in society.

During the month of fasting, there is an increased sense of community, sacrifice and devotion to God. In addition to the five daily prayers, there are nightly family gatherings for the iftari or breaking of the fast. And praying together for forgiveness and good-will is a daily event. Muslims generally break their fast with dates, the traditional fruit of the Arabian peninsula. Along with the dates, special snacks like fried vegetables and spicy lentils are also eaten for iftari. Drinks such as freshly squeezed lemonade mixed with rose-water are also commonly prepared during Ramadan.

As the Islamic calendar follows the lunar cycle, Eid begins with the sighting of the new moon at the end of Ramadan. Each year, the holiday moves back about ten days in accordance with the movement of the lunar cycle. In many countries, festivities begin on the night before Eid, known as the chand raat or the night of the moon. Girls decorate their palms with henna or mehndi, and dance to traditional music, while cooking for the grand feast the next day gets underway.



On Eid morning, families offer a special prayer of thanks to God and then begin the celebrations with food and merriment. In most parts of the world, people give each other gifts and new clothes, children receive money from their elders, special feasts are held for relatives, and desserts adorn the dinner table for days while families and friends reunite in celebration

The Beginnings of Yoga



The beginnings of Yoga are shrouded in the mists of time. The Indian Prime minister, Narendra modi in his UN address suggested the date of 21 June, as it is the longest day of year in the Northern Hemisphere and shares a special significance in many parts of the world. The first International Day of Yoga created a record for the largest yoga class, and another for the largest number of participating nationalities. The Day has been criticised in India as a waste of money, and by religious group as an attempt by India to promote Hinduism through yoga.

आजादी से पूर्व अन्य मंदिरों की भांति इस मंदिर में भी हरिजनों के प्रवेश पर पूर्ण प्रतिबंध था। मंदिर के पुजारी किसी भी गैर ब्राह्मण व्यक्ति को मंदिर में प्रवेश नहीं कराने के पक्ष में रहते थे। हरिजनों के साथ इस भेदभावपूर्ण रवैये के कारण स्थानीय हरिजनों में आक्रोश था परन्तु उनका नेतृत्व संभालने वाला कोई नहीं था। केरल के गांधी समर्थक श्री केलप्पन ने महात्मा की आज्ञा से इस प्रथा के विरुद्ध आवाज उठायी और अंततः इसके लिये सन् 1933 ई 0 में सविनय अवज्ञा प्रारंभ की गयी। मंदिर के ट्रस्टियों को इस बात की ताकीद की गयी कि नये वर्ष का प्रथम दिवस अर्थात् 1 जनवरी 1934 को अंतिम निश्चय दिवस के रूप में मनाया जायेगा और इस तिथि पर उनके स्तर से कोई निश्चय न होने की स्थिति मे महात्मा गांधी तथा श्री केलप्पन द्वारा आन्दोलनकारियों के पक्ष में आमरण अनशन किया जा सकता है। महात्मा गांधी का यह प्रयोग अत्यंत संतोषजनक तथा शिक्षाप्रद रहा। उनके द्वारा दी गयी अनशन की धमकी का उत्साहजनक असर हुआ और श्री गुरुवायूर मंदिर के ट्रस्टियों की ओर से बैठक बुलाकर

मंदिर के उपासको की राय भी प्राप्त की गयी। बैठक मे 77 प्रतिशत उपासको के द्वारा दिये गये बहुमत के आधार पर मंदिर में हरिजनों के प्रवेश को स्वीकृति दे दी गयी और इस प्रकार 1 जनवरी 1934 से केरल के श्री गुरुवायूर मंदिर में किये गये निश्चय दिवस की सफलता के रूप में हरिजनों के प्रवेश को सैद्धांतिक स्वीकृति मिल गयी।

गुरुवायूर मंदिर जिसमें आज भी गैर हिन्दुओं का प्रवेश वर्जित है तथापि कई घर्मों को मानने वाले भगवान भगवान गुरुवायूरप्पन के परम भक्त हैं। इस प्रकार महात्मा गांधी की प्रेरणा से जनवरी माह के प्रथम दिवस को निश्चय दिवस के रूप में मनाया गया और किये गये निश्चय को प्राप्त किया गया। हम सब भी नये वर्ष के प्रथम दिवस को कुछ न कुछ निश्चय अवश्य करते हैं।

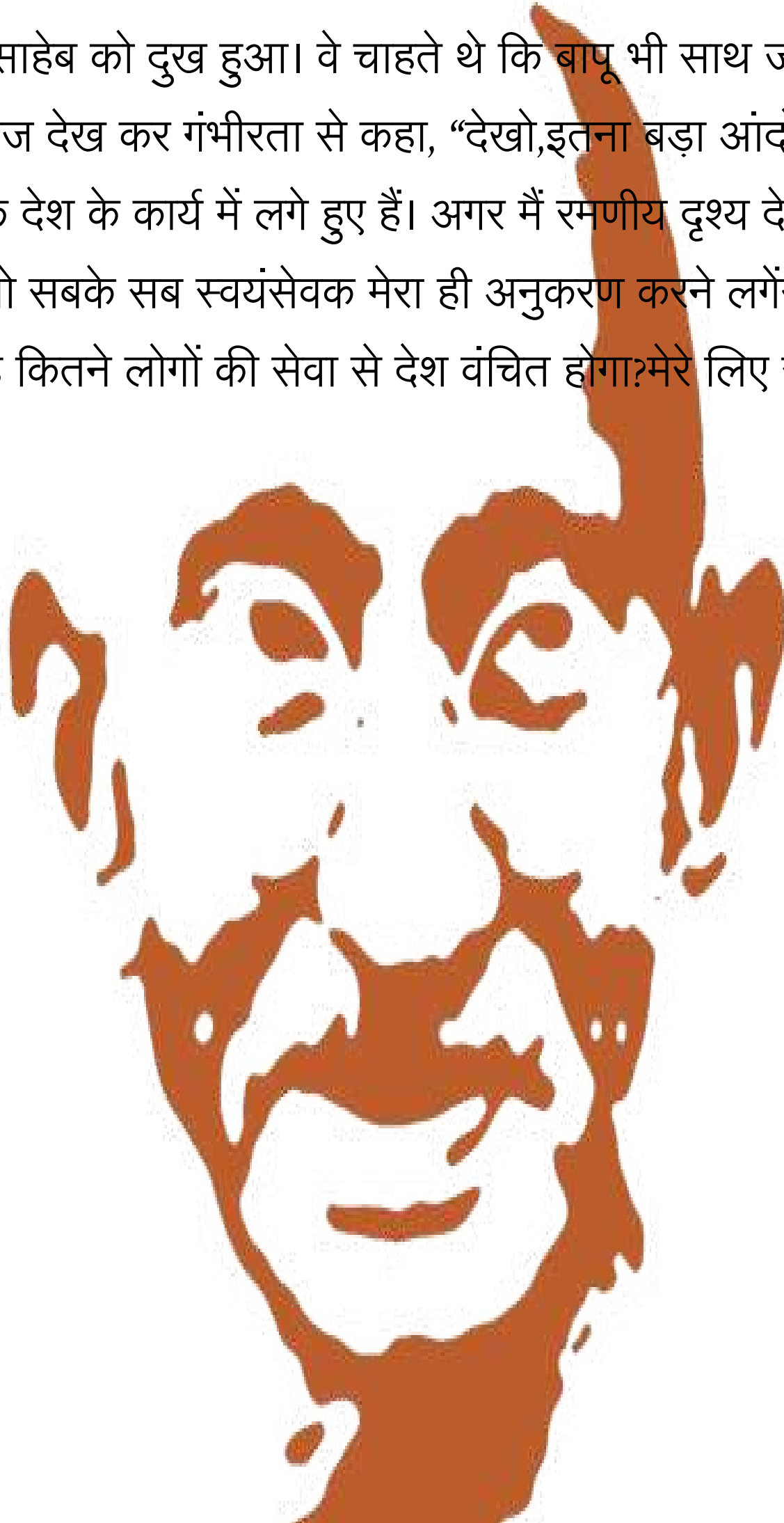

किसी को काम सौंपने के बाद उसके बारे में दर्याफ़्त करते रहना बापू की आदत में शुमार नहीं था। फिर भी उन्होंने ऐसा किया। यह स्पष्ट कर रहा था कि कन्याकुमारी से गांधी जी काफ़ी प्रभावित थे। स्वामी विवेकानन्द भी वहां जाकर भावावेश में आ गए थे और समुद्र में कूद कर कुछ दूर के एक बड़े पत्थर तक तैरते गए थे।

”काकासाहेब ने बापू से पूछा, “आप भी आएंगे न

बापू ने कहा, “बार-बार जाना मेरे नसीब में नहीं है। एक दफ़ा हो आया इतना ही काफ़ी है।”

इस जवाब से काकासाहेब को दुख हुआ। वे चाहते थे कि बापू भी साथ जाएं। बापू ने काकासाहेब को नाराज देख कर गंभीरता से कहा, “देखो,इतना बड़ा आंदोलन लिए बैठा हूं। हज़ारों स्वयंसेवक देश के कार्य में लगे हुए हैं। अगर मैं रमणीय दृश्य देखने का लोभ संवरण न कर सकूं,तो सबके सब स्वयंसेवक मेरा ही अनुकरण करने लगेंगे। अब हिसाब लगाओ कि इस तरह कितने लोगों की सेवा से देश वंचित होगा?मेरे लिए संयम रखना ही अच्छा है।”

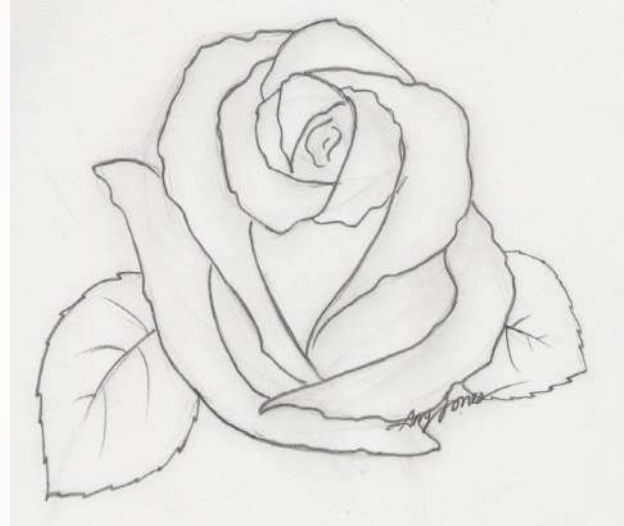
Snowy Path

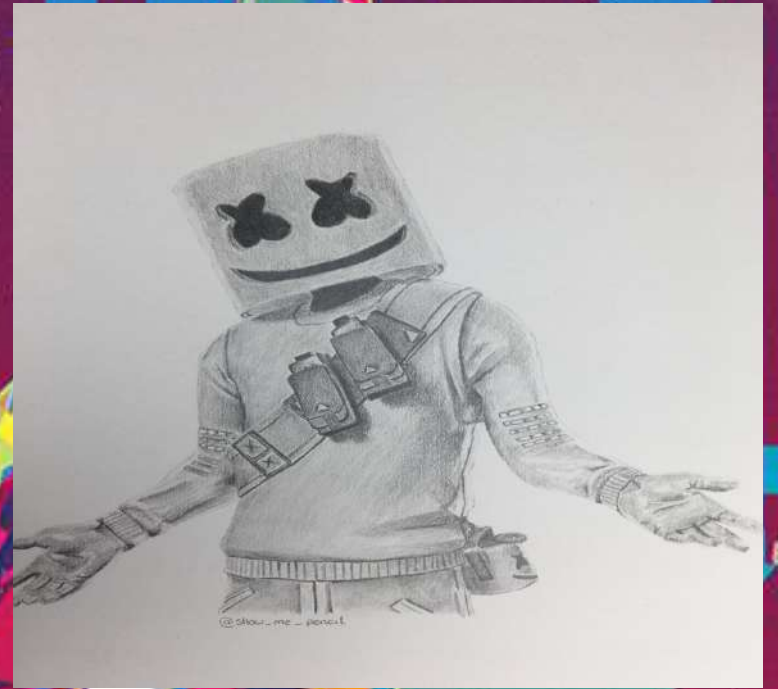

INDIAN ARMY

The Indian Army (Hindi: Bhāratīya Thala Sēnā) is the land based branch and the largest component of the Indian Armed Forces. The President of India is the Supreme Commander of the Indian Army, and it is commanded by the Chief of army force (COAS), who is a four star general. Two officers have been conferred with the rank of field marshal, a five star rank which is a ceremonial position of great honor. The Indian Army originated from the armies of the east Indian company , which eventually became the British Indian Army , and the armies of the princely states, which finally became the national army after independence. The units and regiments of the Indian Army have diverse histories and have participated in a number of battles and campaigns across the world, earning many battle and theater honor before and after Independence. The primary mission of the Indian Army is to ensure national security and national unity, defending the nation from external aggression and internal threats, and maintaining peace and security within its borders. It conducts humanitarian rescue operations during natural calamities and other disturbances, like Operation Surya Hope and can also be requisitioned by the government to cope with internal threats. It is a major component of

national power alongside the Indian Navy and the Indian air force. The army has been involved in four wars with neighbouring Pakistan and one with China. Other major operations undertaken by the army include: Operation vijay, operation meghtoot and operation cactus. Apart from conflicts, the army has conducted large peace time exercises like operation brasstacts and Exercise Shoorveer, and it has also been an active participant in numerous United nations peace keeping mission including those in: Cyprus, Lebanon, Congo, Angola, Cambodia, Vietnam, Namibia, El Salvador, Liberia, Mozambique, South Sudan and Somalia. The Indian Army has a regimental system but is operationally and geographically divided into seven commands, with the basic field formation being a division. It is an all volunteer force and comprises more than 80% of the country's active defence personnel. It is the 2nd largest standing army in the world, with 1,237,117 active troops and 960,000 reserve troops. The army has embarked on an infantry modernisation program known as Futuristic Infantry Soldier As a System, and is also upgrading and acquiring new assets for its armoured, artillery and aviation branches

INDIAN AIR FORCE

The Chief of Air Staff is an officer of the rank of Air Chief Marshal. Our Air Force is divided into seven Commands. The Central, Western, and Southern Air Commands are operational ones. The Training and Maintenance Commands are functional commands. Air Force personnel receive training for flying at the Air Force Academy at Dundigat. Technical and administrative training is provided at Bangalore and Coimbatore respectively. Today the Air Force has a wide variety of modern equipments, weapon systems, communication and detection systems. For example, air superiority fighter – Mig 29 aircraft, multi-role combat aircraft-Mirage 2000 and Su-30 aircraft, strike or air defence aircraft-Jaguar, Mig 21, Mig 23, Mig 25, and Mig 27 aircraft, transport fleet – IL-76, An32, and HAL manufactured Cheetah and Chetak helicopters, Mi 8, Mi 17, and heavy lift Mi 26 helicopter, attack helicopters like Mi 25 and Mi 35 helicopters, some of our aircraft are manufactured at the public sector undertaking, Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) near Bangalore and the rest are purchased from abroad

INDIAN NAVY

The Indian Navy is the naval branch of the armed forces of India. With 55,000 men and women, including 5,000 naval aviation personnel and 2,000 Marine Commandos (MARCOS), it is the world's fifth largest navy. The Indian Navy currently operates more than 155 vessels, including the .aircraft carrier INS Viraat

India uses its navy to enhance its international relations through joint exercises, port visits, and humanitarian missions, including disaster relief. The Indian Navy is increasing its capabilities as a true blue-water navy; the Indian Navy's doctrine states that this is for the collective good of nations.

The Indian Navy is well known to provide emergency relief to the marooned due to natural cause or conflicts in and around the Indian .Ocean
