The four hundred and forty eight articles in the Constitution was sufficient for the convalescence of independent India. The soul of the Indian constitution, ^{the Preface} was written by the first Prime minister Jawahar Lal Nehru, which proclaims the 'unity in diversity' of India by including all Indians.

Our Constitution was prepared by borrowing principles and norms from foreign countries like Russia and Britain. This practise ensured a universal and pervasive administration in India by including



the diversity of in culture and customs. The major challenge before the drafting committee was to ensure equality for all class of people, which is reflected from Preface as the proclamation of the nation to be a Democratic, Socialist, Sovereign and Secular nation. None of the foreign countries had to encounter the challenge as they doesn't contain a myriad of culture and people. This uniqueness of constitution sustains the life of the soul of the Constitution. ~~Dr~~ BR Ambedkar said "Our aim was to create a Constitution resembling a pamphlet" was not able to be fulfilled in order to encounter the challenges in front of a nascent country renowned to be the largest democratic country. So the Constitution of India still holds the record for being the longest, and not merely long but rich in



content and just.

Pivotal Principles for Indian diversity
