# **CRISTIANO RONALDO**

Cristiano Ronaldo, dos Santos Aveiro, born in 5 February 1985. better known as CR7, is a Portuguese professional footballer who plays as a forward, 7 is the jersey number of Cristiano.

He is the captain of the Portuguese national team and he is currently playing at Saudi Arabian football club Al Nassar.

He is considered to be one of the greatest footballers of all time, by some as the greatest ever. Ronaldo began his professional career with Sporting CP at age 17 in 2002, signed for Manchester United a year later. He won three back-to-back Premier League titles. Ronaldo helped United win the UEFA Champions League. He won 1 Ballon d'Or. At one point Ronaldo was the most expensive professional footballer of all time. After moving from Manchester United to Real Madrid, Ronaldo was included in the "World Player of the Decade 2000s", ranking third behind Messi. In the next season, he won his first La Liga title with the club, the 2011-12 La Liga. He won 5 Ballon d'Or in Real Madrid. And he won Copa del Rey, he also won 2nd Champions League with record 17 goals. In 2016 he won his third Champions League. Ronaldo's last season with Real Madrid, he also won his 5th Champions League and scored 2 goals in the final against Juventus. In the third consecutive Champions League, he became the first player to win the UEFA Champions League five times. He would later go on to transfer to Juventus. Ronaldo left the club by holding the record for being top goal scorer in Real Madrid's history, remaining as the only player in La Liga's history to score 30 or more goals in six consecutive seasons

# **BIOGRAPHY OF ISAAC NEWTON:-**

Sir Isaac Newton was born in 1643 and died in 1727. He was a physicist, astronomer, mathematician and a philosopher.

He is considered as one of the greatest figures in the history of science. He was born the year Galileo died. He was greatly influenced by Galileo's work

As a student at Cambridge university in 1661, he became interested in astronomy. He discovered that white light is made up of the same system of colours that are in the rainbow and established the behaviour of light. He published his findings in a book called optics.

Newton also made contributions in mathematics especially in problems related to analytical geometry. He discovered general methods of resolving problems of curvature, as stated in his "method of fluxion".

Newton used the term "fluxion" [The Latin meaning of flow] because he thought of a quantity "flowing" from one magnitude to another.

Newton is known as for his theory on gravitation. According to a popular story, Newton discovered gravity when he saw an apple falling from an apple tree. It was this incident that made Newton realise that it was

a similar force needed to hold the moon in its orbit, comparing this force with the force pulling an object to the ground. He wrote the principle in three stages where he described gravitation as the most important force controlling the motion of celestial bodies. His laws of motion and universal gravitation predicted very accurately the motion of stars and the planets around the sun.
