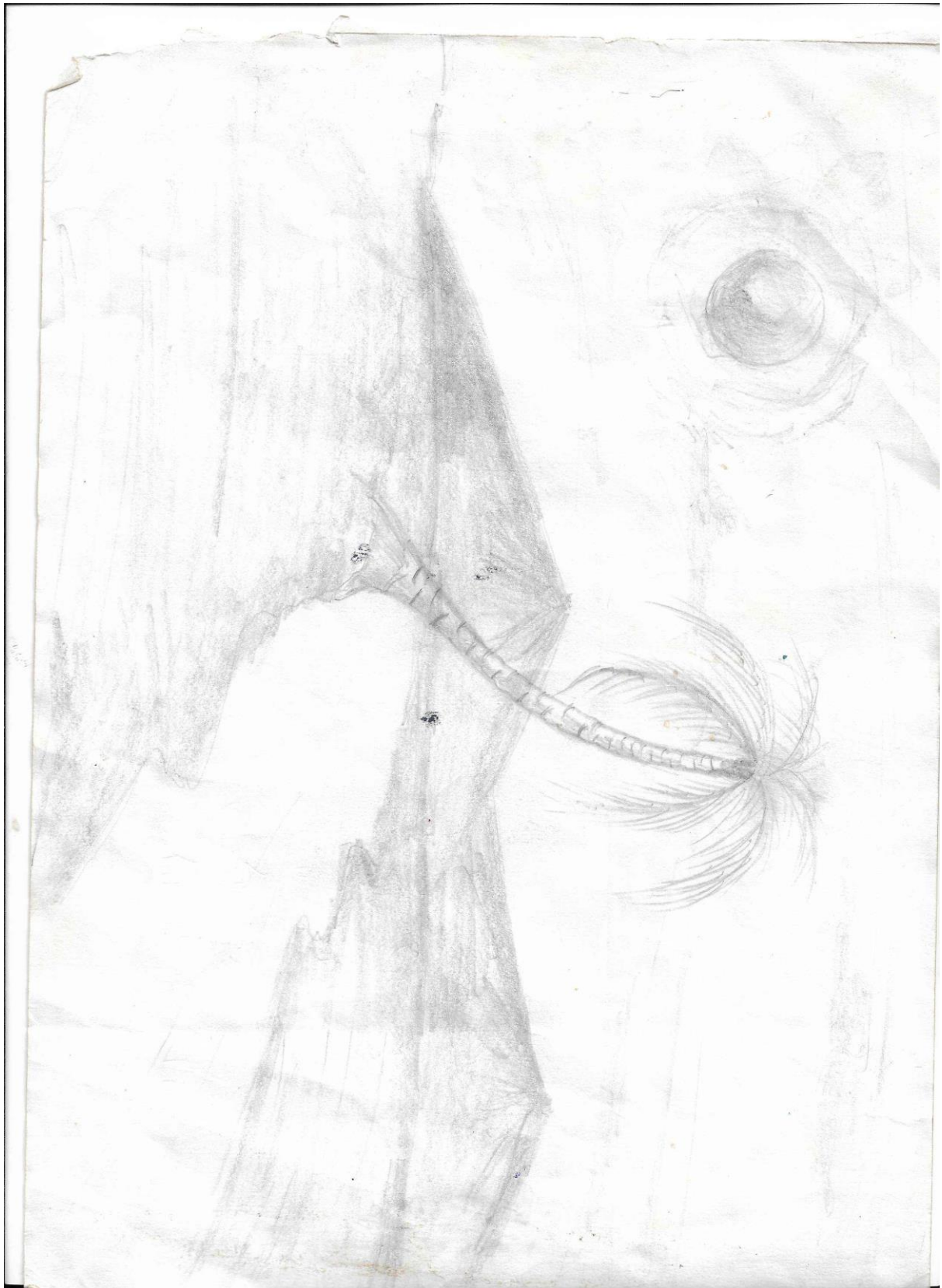

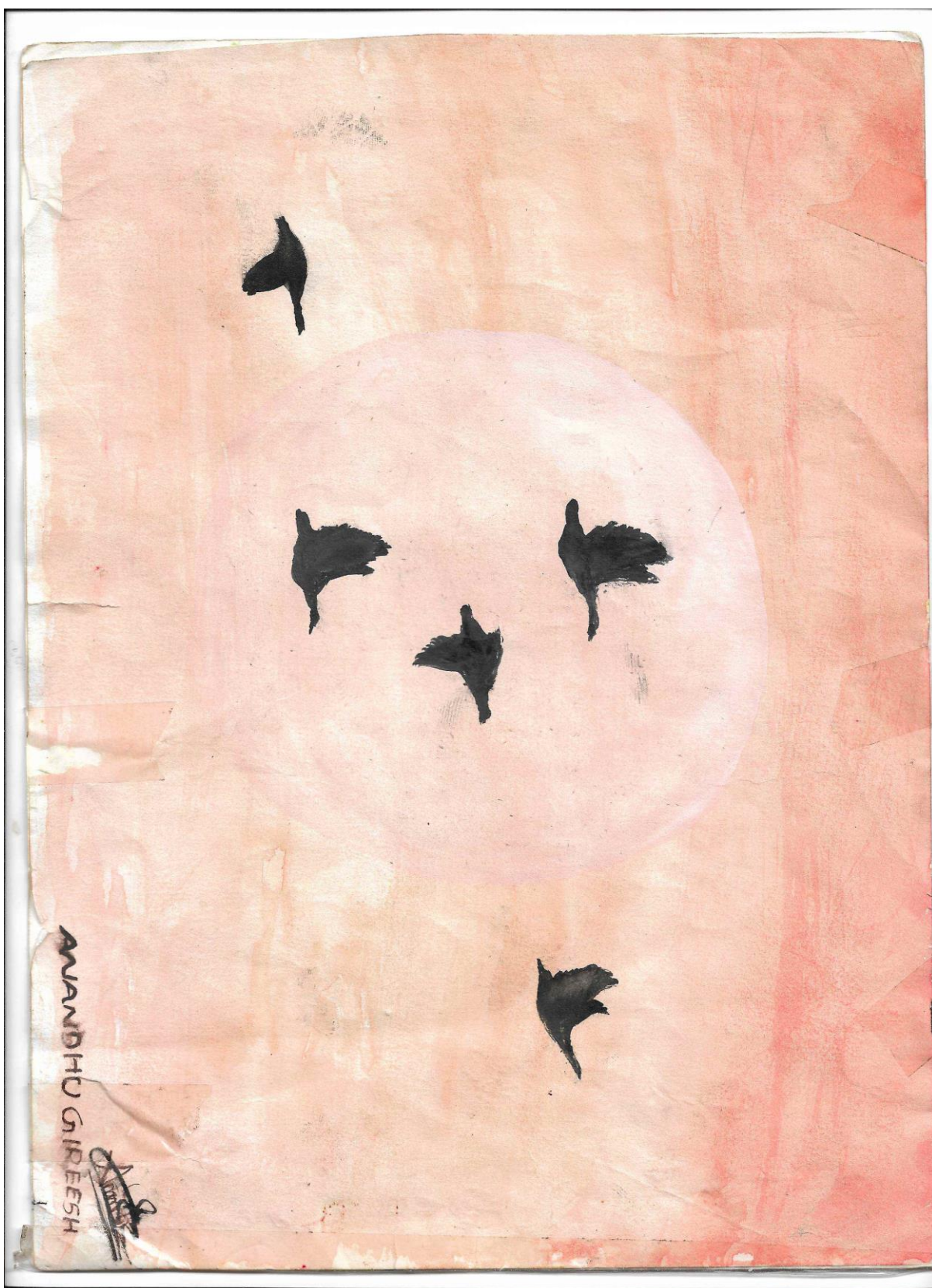




INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

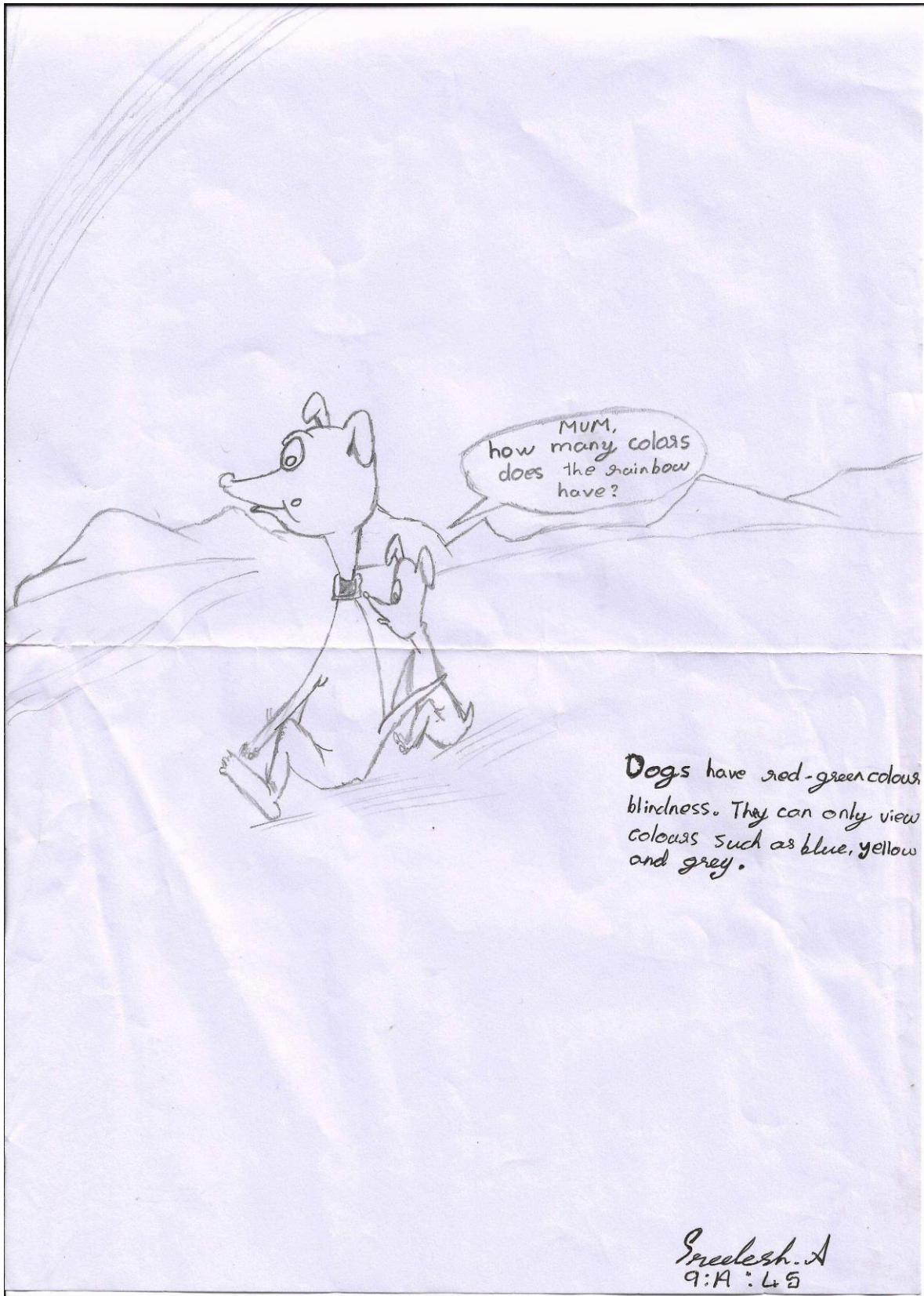

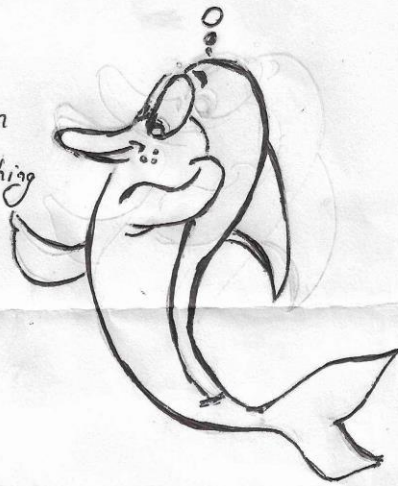

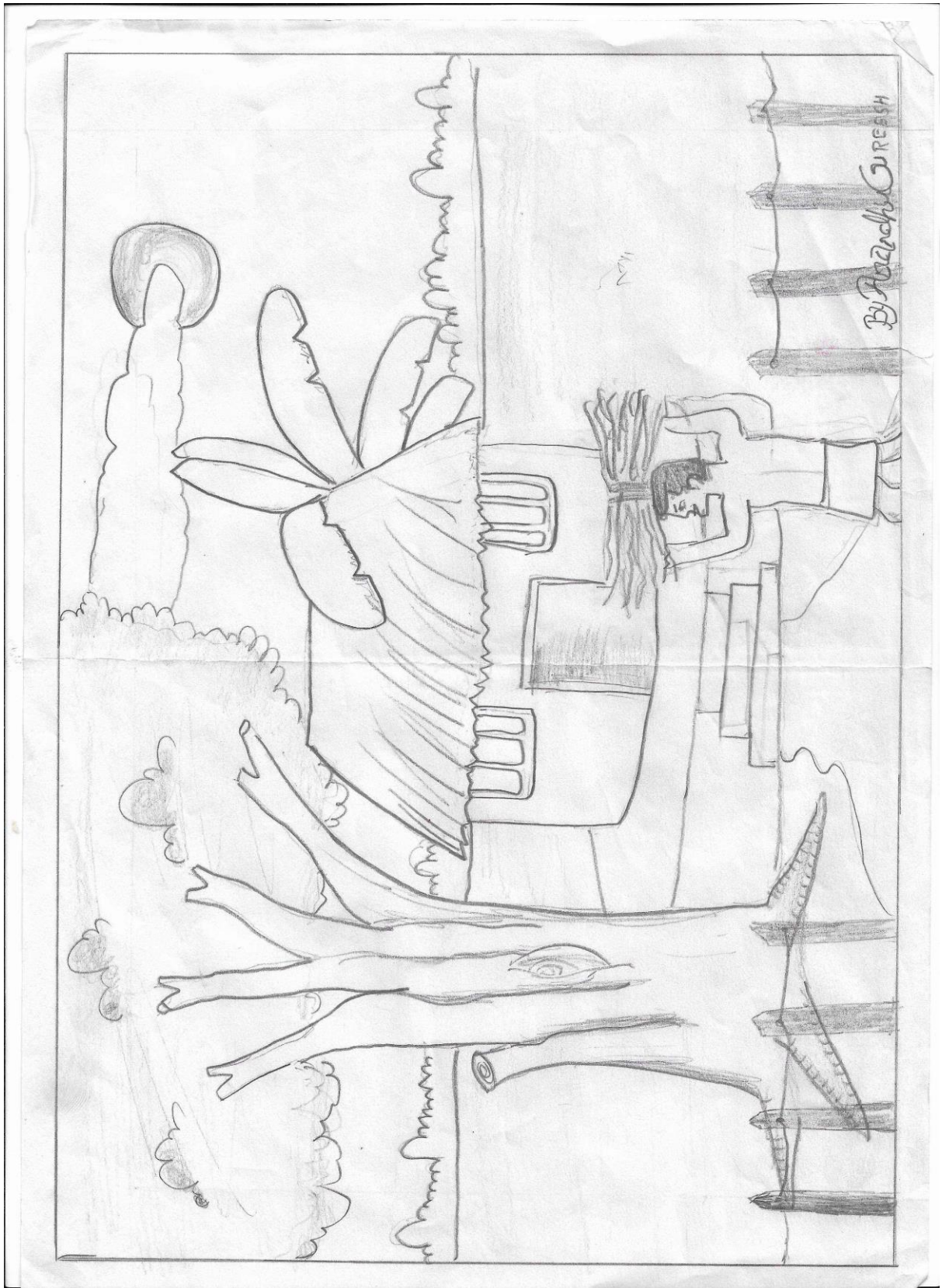

WILD FIRE

What seems to have caught attention of Government and Environmentalist is the fact that the 'Forest Fire' often reduces the space for wildlife and accentuate the man-animal conflict in the region where villages are also located. In Pauri and Chamoli were reserve forest is immensely rich in wild life, including tigers and elephants, there are reports of consistent human encroachment in the forest area. Environmentalists suspect that much of the fire in the woods is deliberately stoked to shrink the forest cover and expand the human habitation. In large areas comprising Himalayan foothills known as Terai, farmers are known for encroaching into forest area and expanding their possession of land. There are a large number of cases in which tigers, elephants, leopards are coming in direct conflict with the humans. In Haridwar and adjoining areas, herds of elephants are often seen blocking the highway as their habitat has shrunk due to encroachment by the humans.

Environmentalists and forest officials do not rule out the possibility that frequent fires in forest covers of Uttarakhand would be linked to human greed of expanding its domain at the expense of forest cover. Officials of the home ministry say that in view of the concerns expressed by local stake holders on destruction of forest cover, a comprehensive strategy needs to be chalked out to deal with this kind of situation.
