Although it has basic facilities, the physical situation is very backward. Although the academic conditions are in a good state, this school is very backward in terms of the number of children. There is no doubt that the number of children will increase if the physical conditions improve. The all-round progress of this institution, where many thousands of people in this country have written their first letters of knowledge, is due to the collective efforts of teachers, parents and locals. The Panchayat, SMC, voluntary organizations, various institutions, individuals, PTA, and BRC are working together to focus on the development of the school.

## HISTORY

The land belonging to the Kurukkunnapuram church in Marady was later given to the government. In 1913, the school, which was owned by the church, became a government school. This school, located in the courtyard of the Kurukkunnapuram church, is one of the oldest schools in the district. This school, which used to have a large number of students, is currently experiencing a shortage of students like all other government schools. However, it is moving forward with the confidence that it will rise with the cooperation of good locals and former students.

## CURRENT SITUATION ANALYSIS

### A. Physical - Achievements

With the help of various individuals, desks, benches, shelves, chairs and other equipment for the classrooms have been provided. A toilet for the children has been constructed by the Panchayat.

A computer has been made available from the ML. A. Fund.

### B. Physical...Limitations

There is no building with facilities for offices, staff rooms, labs, libraries, kitchens, classrooms, etc.

There are no facilities for pre-primary classes. A stage for the school is essential. There is no play area for children. The children's play area should be nurtured. Garden construction should be improved. It is necessary to build a biodiversity park in the school to develop environmental awareness among children.

In addition to classes 1 to 4, pre-primary classes are also being conducted in this school. Two permanent teachers, including the headmistress, two temporary teachers, a primary teacher, a part-time menial staff member, and a cook are serving in this school. As of the 6th working day, the student strength is 24, covering classes from LKG to 4th grade.

Classes from LKG to class 4 are going well. Special attention is paid to ensuring academic achievement. Parents' meetings are called and special awareness classes are conducted. Because the cooperation of parents is very essential for the academic excellence of children. The teachers, non-teaching staff and PTA members of this school work hard towards the goal of shaping a socially responsible society, beyond just getting marks.
