A.P.J Abdul Kalam childhood

APJ Abdul Kalam was born into a poor Tamil Muslim family in the pilgrimage town of Rameswaram, Tamil Nadu, on October 15, 1931. His mother, Ashiamma, was a housewife and his father, Jainulabdeen, was an imam of a local mosque and a boat owner. He was the youngest in the family with four elder brothers and a sister.

Though, the family was not financially affluent yet all the children were raised in an atmosphere that was full of love and compassion. In order to add to the family's income, Kalam had to sell newspapers during his early years.

He was an average student during his school, but possessed a strong desire to learn and was very hard working. He loved mathematics and spent hours studying the subject. He pursued his education from 'Schwartz Higher Secondary School,' and then graduated from 'Saint Joseph's College, Tiruchirappalli,' in 1954. He wanted to become a fighter pilot but his dream could not be fulfilled as there were only eight positions available in the IAF and he secured the ninth place.

Charles Babbage, the father of computer

Charles Babbage - The Father of the Computer

Today's technology connects humanity with one another, no matter what the distance may be.

Without one man in particular, many of today's advances in technology may not exist. Thanks to the designs and inventions made by Charles

Babbage, we are able to share knowledge and create and maintain bonds with people all over the world. Charles Babbage overcame technological inadequacies in his time by designing new creations despite a lack of funds to build them, inventing items that helped medical and other scientific advancements, and inspired many other scientists and inventors. Charles Babbage designed many inventions, including "a cow-catcher for the front end of railway locomotives, failsafe

For many years, the British government funded his projects.

However, they eventually withdrew their funding, and Mr. Babbage was forced to temporarily give up on building his projects (Charles Babbage). One of Charles Babbage's inventions was the ophthalmoscope (Computer History). The ophthalmoscope is used to examine one's retina during eye exams. Without this invention, doctors may not have been able to detect many visual disorders before they occurred. Mr. Babbage also "proposed 'black box' recorders for monitoring the conditions preceding railway catastrophes" (Computer History). This black box "measured the speed of the train and its degree of vibration" (History of Computers).



Drug abuse & After effects

More than **7 million** people suffer from illicit drug use disorder and **one in four deaths** can be attributed to alcohol, tobacco, and illicit or prescription drug use.¹

Drugs are chemicals that affect the body and brain. Different drugs can have different effects. Some effects of drugs include health consequences that are long-lasting and permanent. They can even continue after a person has stopped taking the substance.

There are a few ways a person can take drugs, including injection, inhalation and ingestion. The effects of the drug on the body can depend on how the drug is delivered. For example, the injection of drugs directly into the bloodstream has an immediate impact, while ingestion has a delayed effect. But all misused drugs affect the brain. They cause large amounts of dopamine, a neurotransmitter that helps regulate our emotions, motivation and feelings of pleasure, to flood the brain and produce a "high." Eventually, drugs can change how the brain works and interfere with a person's ability to make choices, leading to intense cravings and compulsive drug use. Over time, this behavior can turn into a substance dependency, or drug addiction.

THE EFFECTS OF DRUG ABUSE ON HEALTH

Substance use disorders are associated with a wide range of short- and long-term health effects. They can vary depending on the type of drug, how much and how often it's taken and the person's general health. Overall, the effects of drug abuse and dependence can be far-reaching. They can impact almost every organ in the human body.

Side effects of drug addiction may include:

- A weakened immune system, increasing the risk of illness and infection
- Heart conditions ranging from abnormal heart rates to heart attacks and collapsed veins and blood vessel infections from injected drugs
- Nausea and abdominal pain, which can also lead to changes in appetite and weight loss
- Increased strain on the liver, which puts the person at risk of significant liver damage or liver failure
- Seizures, stroke, mental confusion and brain damage
- Lung disease
- Problems with memory, attention and decision-making, which make daily living more difficult
- Global effects of drugs on the body, such as breast development in men and increases in body temperature, which can lead to other health problems
