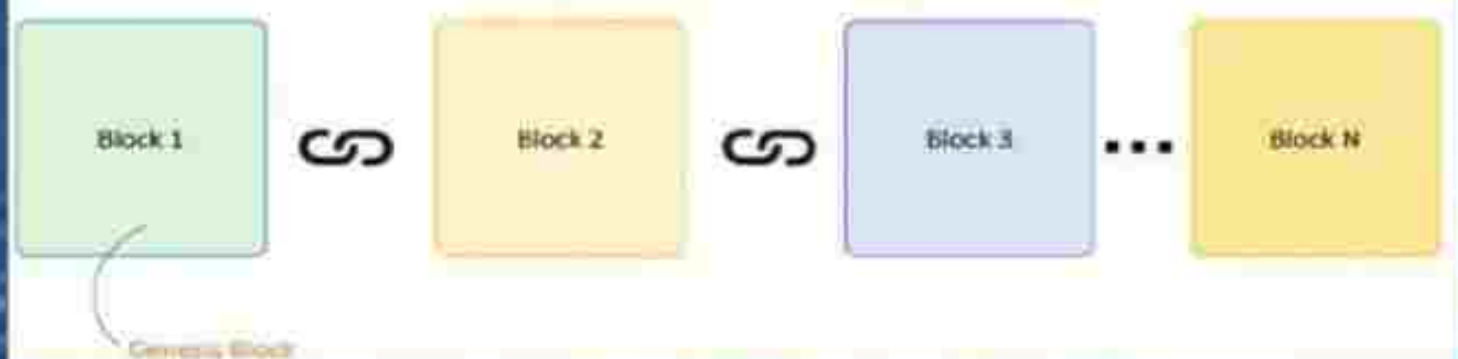
What Is Blockchain Technology

The blockchain industry is still relatively young but is growing rapidly. Blockchain is a distributed database that is shared among the nodes of a computer network. As a database, a blockchain stores information electronically in digital format. It is a system of recording information in a way that makes it difficult or impossible to change, hack, or cheat the system.

Blockchains are best known for their crucial role in cryptocurrency systems, such as Bitcoin, for maintaining a secure and decentralized record of transactions. The innovation with a blockchain is that it guarantees the authenticity and security of a record of data and generates trust without the need for a trusted third party. The blockchain is used for the secure transfer of items like money, property, contracts, etc, without requiring a third-party intermediary like a bank or government. Once data is recorded inside a blockchain, it is very difficult to change it. It is a chain of blocks which contain information.

The data which is stored inside a block depends on the type of blockchain. For example, A Bitcoin Block contains information about the Sender, Receiver, number of bitcoins to be transferred. Each Block has Data, Hash and Hash of the previous block.

Blockchain is chain of Blocks that contains Data

Amount: 200



Each new block in the chain is linked to the previous block. A block also has a hash. A hash can be understood as a fingerprint which is unique to each block. Consider the following example, where we have a chain of 3 blocks. The 1st block has no predecessor. Hence, it does not contain the previous block. Block 2 contains a hash of block 1, while block 3 contains Hash of block 2.



Hence, all blocks are containing hashes of previous blocks. This is the technique that makes a blockchain so secure. The goal of blockchain is to allow digital information to be recorded and distributed, but not edited. Some reasons why Blockchain technology has become so popular:

Whats Wrong With Keeping Birds In Cages?



All caged birds have either been captured or bred in captivity. In the wild, these beautiful beings are never alone, and if they are separated from their flock, even for a moment, they fly wildly to their flock-mates. These social animals preen each other, fly together, play, and share egg-incubation duties. Life in captivity is a death sentence for birds, who suffer from malnutrition, loneliness, and the stress of confinement to improper environments. The Los Angeles Times reported that "parrots quickly become frustrated 'perch potatoes' in captivity. Many end up obese and with serious behavioural problems such as screaming, biting, and self-mutilation by plucking out their feathers." James Serpell, Director of the Center for the Interaction of Animals and Society at the University of Pennsylvania says: "Parrots are the primates of the bird world. They aren't content to sit on a perch and sing" Imagine yourself in a cage for years. Many of these caged birds are now nearing extinction as they are caught from the wild.

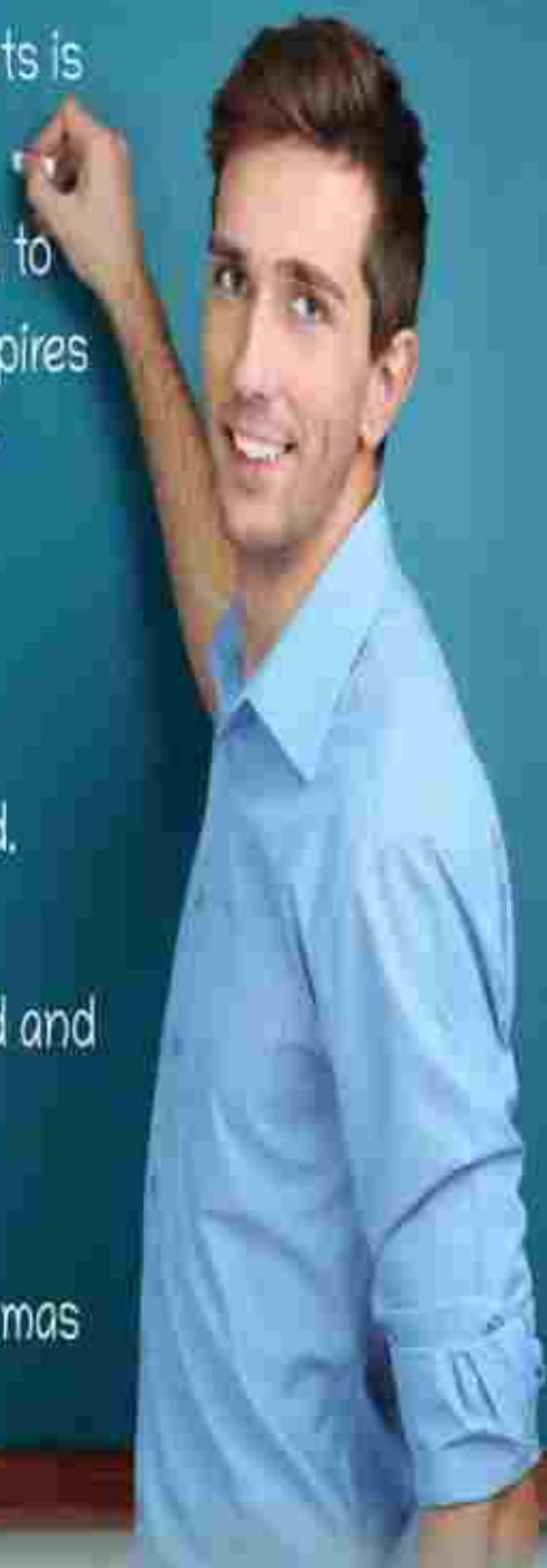

The first computers were very big. They were the size of a room! They were so big that people didn't have them at home. Early computers could also only do simple maths, like a calculator. In the 1930s Alan Turing had the idea for a computer you could program to do different things.

In 1958 Jack Kilby invented the microchip. Microchips are tiny but can store lots of information. They helped make computers smaller. In the 1970s computers were smaller and cheaper so people started to use them at home. In the 1980s computer games were very popular. Lots of people bought computers just to play games.



In 1989 Tim Berners-Lee invented the World Wide Web, which is a way to organise information on the internet. Now people all over the world can look for and share information on websites.

Today people can use smartphones to play games, email and go on the internet. In the past a simple computer was the size of a room. Now it can go in your pocket!
