As we comprehend, that AI

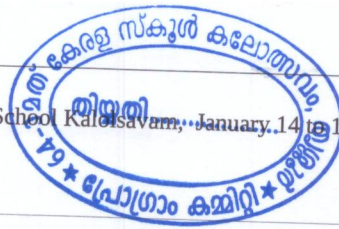

The Paradox of Creativity and AI

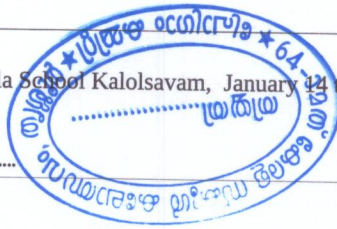
