India possesses a distinct identity not only because of its geography, history and culture but also because of great diversity of its natural ecosystem.

Biodiversity is everywhere. It is extremely complex, dynamic and varied like no other feature of earth. Biodiversity is the foundation of life on earth. It occurs both on land and in water; from high altitudes to deep ocean trenchers and it includes all organisms from microscopic bacteria to more complex plants. It is crucial for the functioning of ecosystems which we can't live. It strongly affects our social relations and gives us freedom and choice. Biodiversity is essential to global food security and nutrition and also serves as a safety net to poor house holds during times of crisis. It is crucial for human well being sustainable development and poverty reduction. With the help of this rich biodiversity we are leading a comfortable life. We depend on biodiversity for our security and health.

India contains a great wealth biodiversity in its forests, its wetlands and in its, aroma areas. The rich biodiversity is so vast (about 100 million species). India has a rich variety of wet land habitats. 18.4% of total area are wetlands. The nearshore coastal waters of India are extremely rich fishing grounds. The total commercial marine catch for India has stabilized over the last ten years at between 1.4 and 1.6 million tones

Tropical evergreen forests, Tropical monsoon moist monsoon forests are richer in species than on the mainland. Coral reefs occur along only a few sections of the mainland. India's coral

reefs have a wide range of resources which are of commercial value.

Every decision we take affects biodiversity and so affects our lives and lives of other people. Deforestation, uncontrolled pollution problems like Soil pollution, water pollution, Air pollution Mining, massive quarrying, Unsustainable tourism, Soil erosion etc...Causes destruction of bio diversity. By changing the equilibrium of biodiversity, we strongly affect human well being and well being of every other living creature .

Biodiversity is the visible expression of difference in all living organisms on this earth. Conservation of the biodiversity of a country of a country and the ways natural resources are utilized for the substances of life will decide the progress and economic stability of the country. HELEN KELLER

Helen Keller was born on 27th June 1880. She was an American author, political activist and lecture .She was the deaf and blind person to earn a bachelor of arts degree . The story of how Keller’s teacher, Anne Sullivan, broken through the isolation imposed by a near complete lack of language, allowing the girl to blossom as she learned to communicate, has become widely known through the dramatic depictions of the play and film .The miracle worker. Her birthplace in west Tuscumbia, Alabama, is now a Museum and sponsors an annual “Helen Keller Day ” .Her birthday on June 27 is commeorated as Helen Keller Day in the US state of Pennsylvania and was authorized at the federal level by president Jimmy Carter in 1980,the 100th anniversary of her birth . She died on 1st June 1968.
