ITALY IS CONSIDERED THE LAND OF BEAUTY AND ART, BUT IT NEVER HAD ANY PHILOSOPHICAL BACKGROUND UNTIL CROCE CAME ALONG. HIS PARENTS SENT HIM TO STUDY THEOLOGICAL SCIENCE IN THE CATHOLIC BACKGROUND.

मेरी धनुष्कोडी यात्रा.

कई सालों से मुझे धनुष्कोडी जाने की इच्छा थी । क्या तुम धनुष्कोडी के बारे में सुना हो ?



धनुषकोडी ही भारत और श्रीलंका के बीच केवल स्थलीय सीमा है जो पाक जलसन्धि में बालू के टीले पर सिर्फ 50 गज की लंबाई में विश्व के लघुतम स्थानों में से एक है। 1964 के चक्रवात से पहले, धनुषकोडी एक उभरता हुआ पर्यटन और तीर्थ स्थल था। चूंकि सीलोन (अब श्रीलंका) केवल 18 मील दूर है, धनुषकोडी और सिलोन के थलइमन्नार के बीच यात्रियों और सामान को समुद्र के पार ढोने के लिए कई साप्ताहिक फेरी सेवाएं थीं। इन तीर्थयात्रियों और यात्रियों की आवश्यकताओं की पूर्ति के लिए वहां होटल, कपड़ों की दुकानें और धर्मशालाएं थी। धनुषकोडी के लिए रेल लाइन- जो तब रामेश्वरम नहीं जाती थी और जो 1964 के चक्रवात में नष्ट हो गई- सीधे मंडपम से धनुषकोडी जाती थी। उन दिनों धनुषकोडी में रेलवे स्टेशन, एक लघु रेलवे अस्पताल, एक पोस्ट ऑफिस और कुछ सरकारी विभाग जैसे मतस्य पालन आदि थे।

चक्रवात से पहले, मद्रास एगमोर (अब चेन्नई एगमोर) से बोट मेल कही जाने वाली रेल सेवा थी और यह सिलोन के लिए फेरी के द्वारा यात्रा करने वाले यात्रियों के लिए लिंक रेल थी। 1964 के चक्रवात के दौरान, 20 फीट की व्यापक लहर शहर के पूर्व से पाक खाड़ी/जलसंधि से शहर पर आक्रमण करते हुए आई और पूरे शहर को नष्ट कर दिया, एक यात्री रेलगाड़ी और पंबन रेल स्टेशन खुद रूप से यह सब रात में घटित हुआ। तूफान कई मायनों में अनोखा था।



रामेश्वरम का तूफान केवल इतनी कम अक्षांश पर नहीं निर्मित हुआ था लेकिन यह लगभग इसी अक्षांश एक भयंकर चक्रवातीय लहर के रूप में तीव्र हो गया जो वास्तव में एक दुर्लभ घटना है। 21 दिसम्बर 1964 के बाद, 250 से 350 मील प्रति घंटे की दर से इसकी गति, लगभग एक सीधी रेखा में, पश्चिम की ओर हो गई। 22 दिसम्बर को यह सीलोन के वावुनिया (अब श्रीलंका कहा जाता है) को 150 केटीएस (लगभग 270 कि.मी/घंटा) की वायु की तीव्रता के साथ पार कर गया, रात में पाक स्ट्रीट में पवेश कर गया और 22-23 दिसम्बर 1964 की रात में रामेश्वरम द्वीप के धनुषकोडी से टकरा गया। यह अनुमान लगाया गया था कि जब इसने रामेश्वरम को पार किया तो समुद्री लहरें 8 गज उंची थी। शशि एम कुलशरेष्ठ और मदन जी गुप्ता द्वारा 'रामेश्वरम के तूफान का उपग्रह अध्ययन' शीर्षक तूफान का वैज्ञानिक अध्ययन इन लिंक पर दिया गया है^[1]

उस दुर्भाग्यपूर्ण रात (22 दिसंबर) को 23.55 बजे धनुषकोडी

रेलवे स्टेशन में प्रवेश करने के दौरान, ट्रेन संख्या 653, पंबन-धनुषकोडी पैसेजंर, एक दैनिक नियमित सेवा जो पंबन से 110 यात्रियों और 5 रेलवे कर्मचारियों के साथ रवाना हुई, यह एक व्यापक समुद्री लहर के चपेट में तब आई जब यह धनुषकोडी रेलवे स्टेशन से कुछ ही गज दूर थी। पूरी ट्रेन सभी 115 लोगों को मौत के साथ बहा ले जाई गई। कुल मिलाकर 1800 से अधिक लोग चक्रवाती तूफान में मारे गए। धनुषकोडी के सभी रिहायशी घर और अन्य संरचनाएं तूफान में बर्बाद हो गए। इस द्वीप पर करीब 10 किलोमीटर से चलती हुई लहरीय हवाएं चलीं और पूरे शहर को बर्बाद कर दिया। इस विध्वंस में पंबन से तु उच्च लहरीय हवाओं द्वारा बहा दिया गया। प्रत्यक्षदर्शी स्मरण करते हैं कि हलोरे लेता पानी कैसे केवल रामेश्वरम के मुख्य मंदिर के ठीक करीब ठहर गया था जहां सैकड़ों लोग तूफान के कहर से शरण लिए थे। इस आपदा के बाद, मद्रास सरकार ने इस शहर को भूतहा शहर के रूप में और रहने के लिए अयोग्य घोषित कर दिया। केवल कुछ मछुआरे अब वहाँ रहते हैं।



इतना सुन्दर भूभाग देखने का सौभाग्य मुझे मिला। इस पर मैं बहुत संतुष्ट हूँ। साथ ही हमारे प्रिय राष्ट्रपति श्री A P J ABDUL KALAM का जन्म स्थान रामेश्वरम देखने का और कलाम का घर जाने का अवसर मिली। अब वही जगह एक प्रदर्शनी जगह है।
अवसर आने पर तुम भी वहाँ जाओ और आस्वादन करो।

One Coulomb Charge

The unit of electric charge is coulomb. If the repulsive force between two identically charged point objects kept at a distance 1 metre is $9 \times 10^9 \text{ N}$, then the charge in each of them will be 1 coulomb. This is equal to the charge of 6.25×10^{18} electrons.

A force of $9 \times 10^9 \text{ N}$ is equivalent to the force exerted by the earth on an object of mass 10^9 kg kept on the surface of the earth. If 10^9 kg is approximately the mass of 1 elephant, 10^9 kg mass is approximately equal to the mass of one lakh elephants.
