The radio is just over a hundred years old it was Marconi who invented an instrument to send the wireless message.

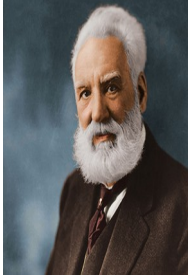
