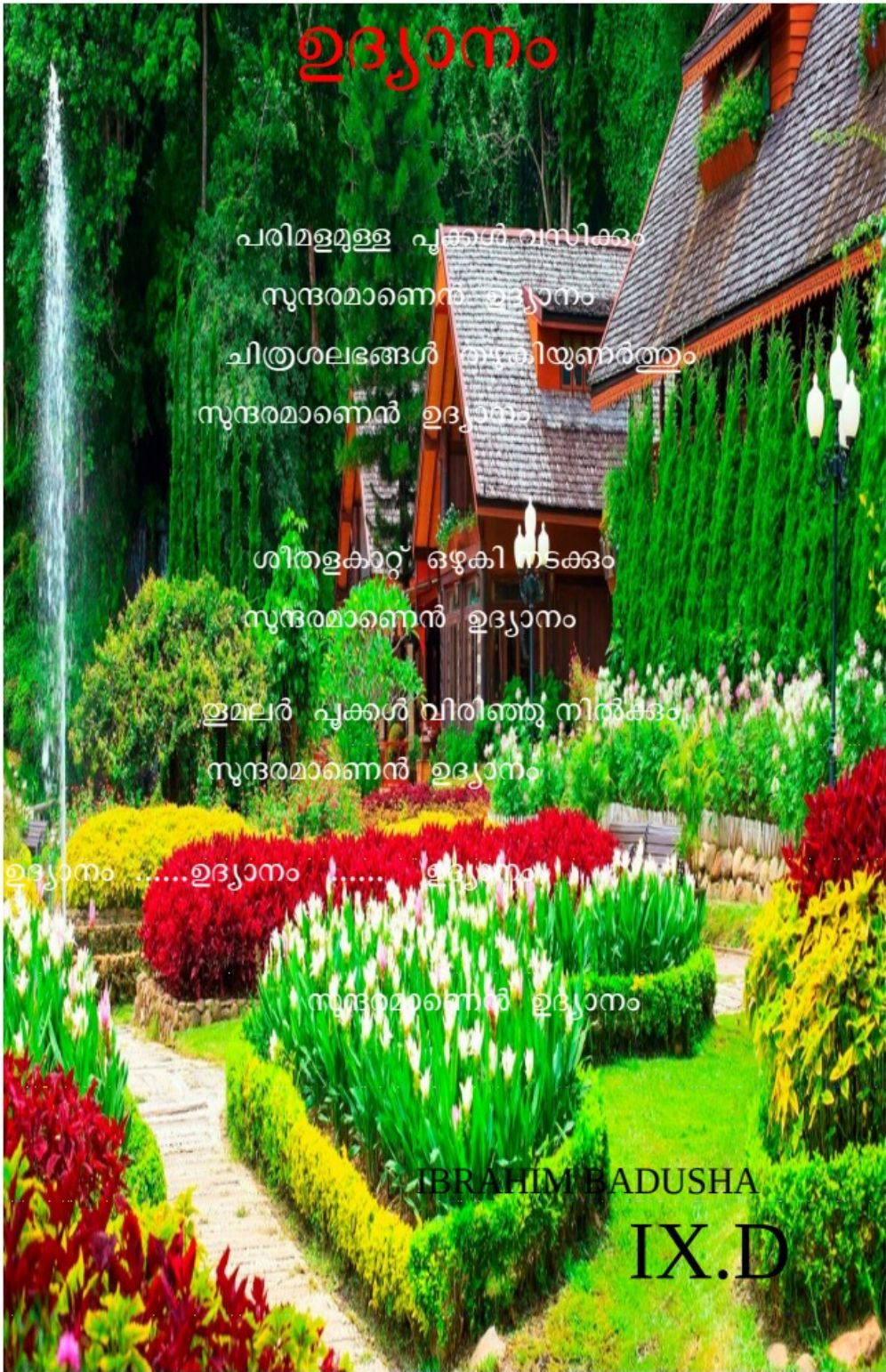



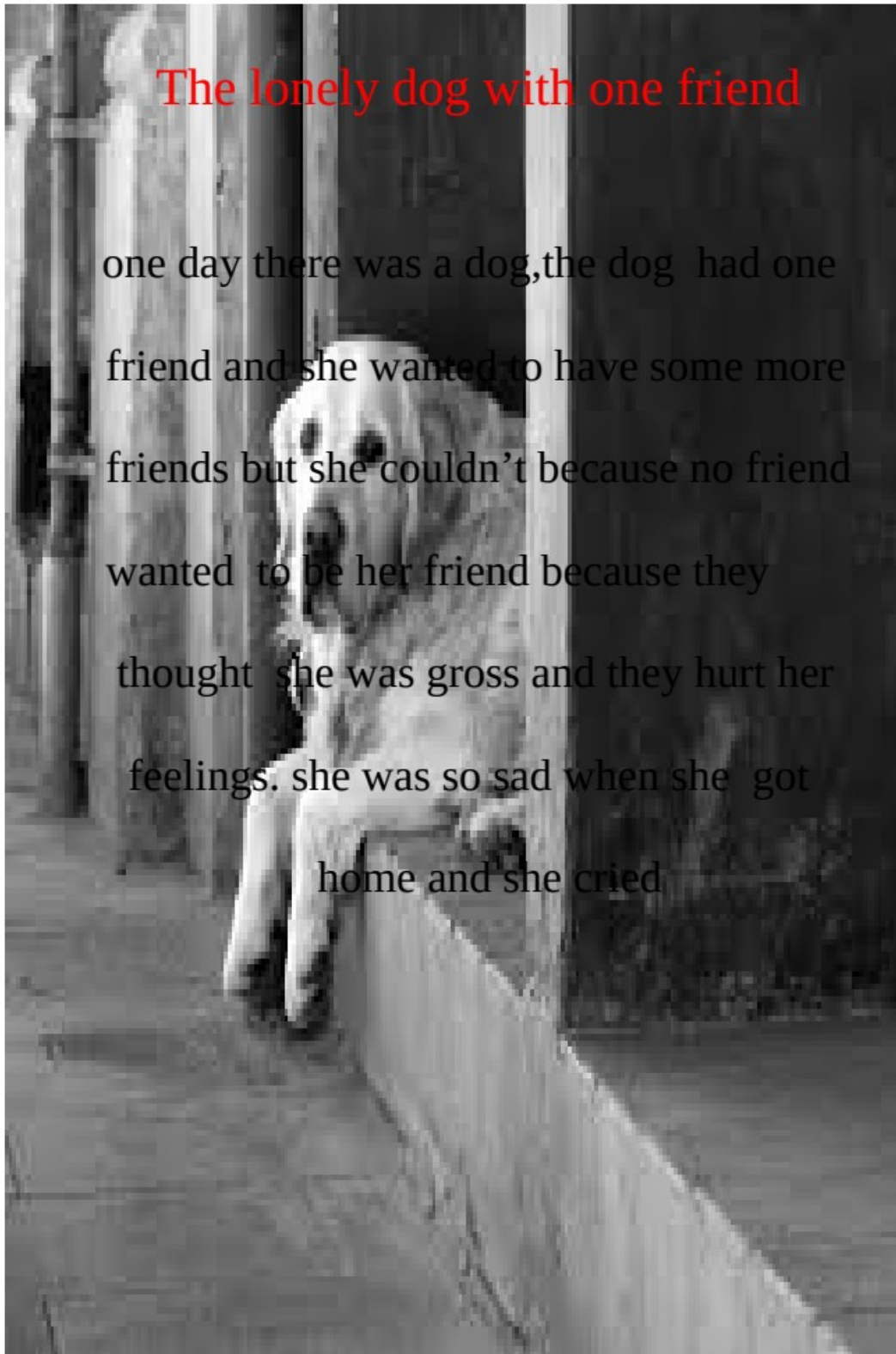

he was many a time arrested and sent to jail he became mahatma or the great soul , to every indian for his unrelenting struggle for india's freedom on the fateful day of january 30 1948

he breathed his last after being shot by fanatic nataram godse
