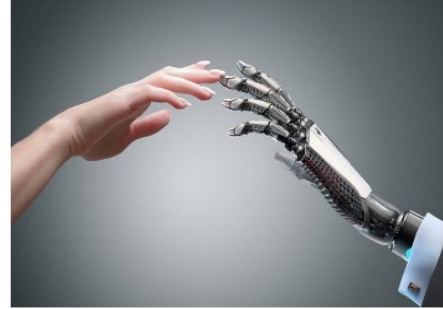

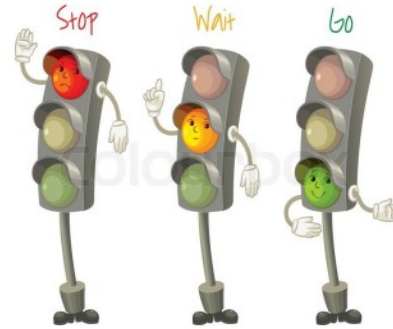

abled learners in education institutes as well as corporate organizations. Our technology is developing day by day so our future will be a generation with full of new ideas and innovation.

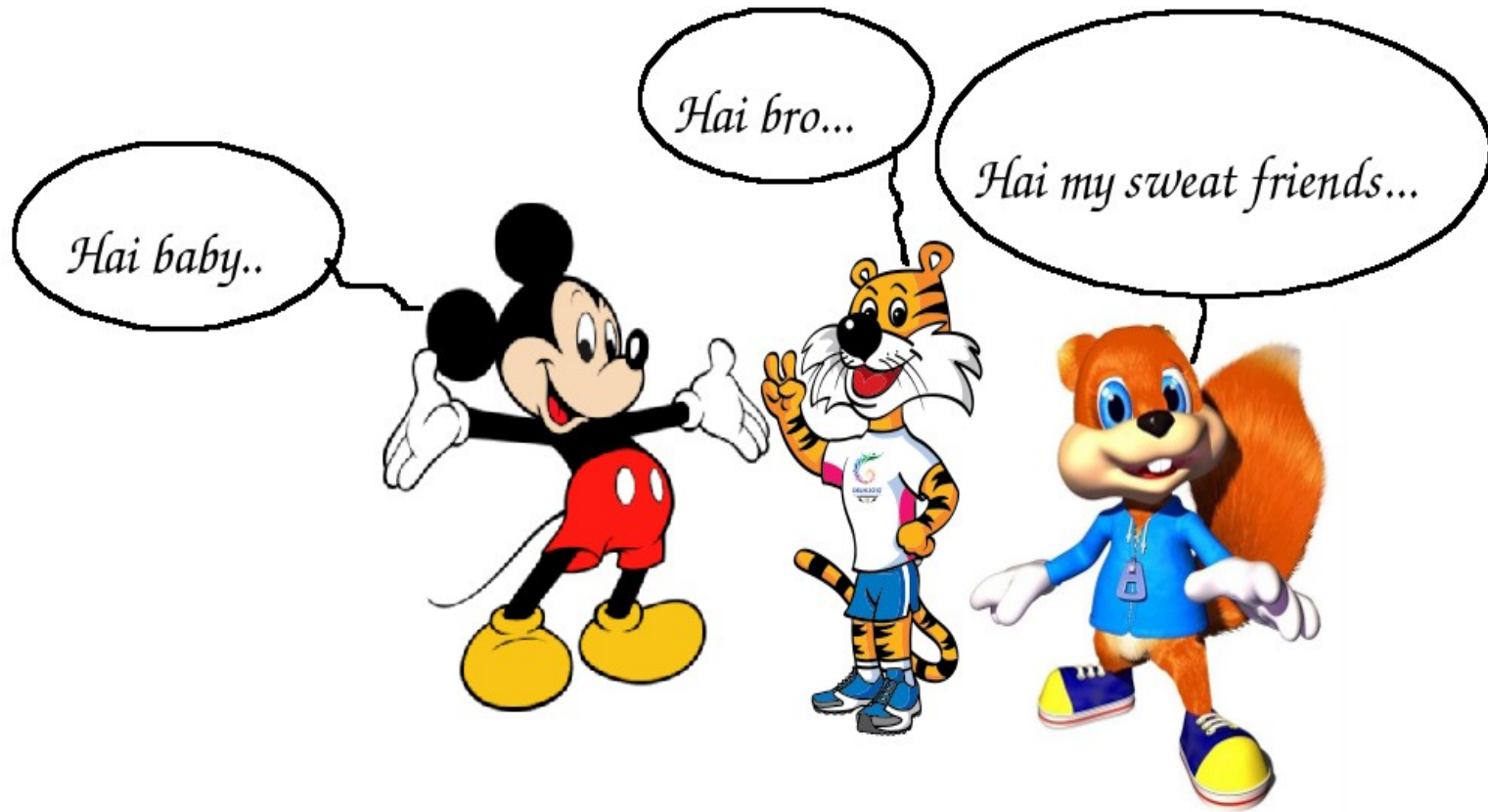
We can help them in many ways.

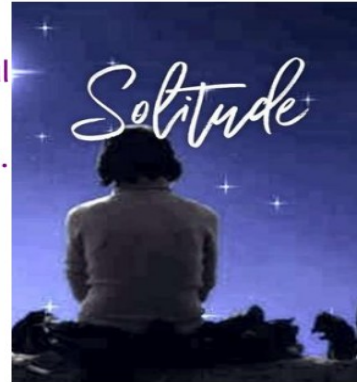

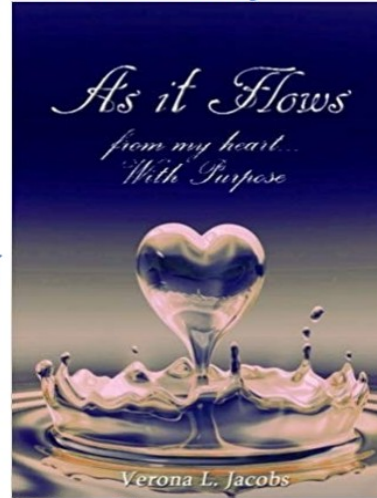

AMBITION

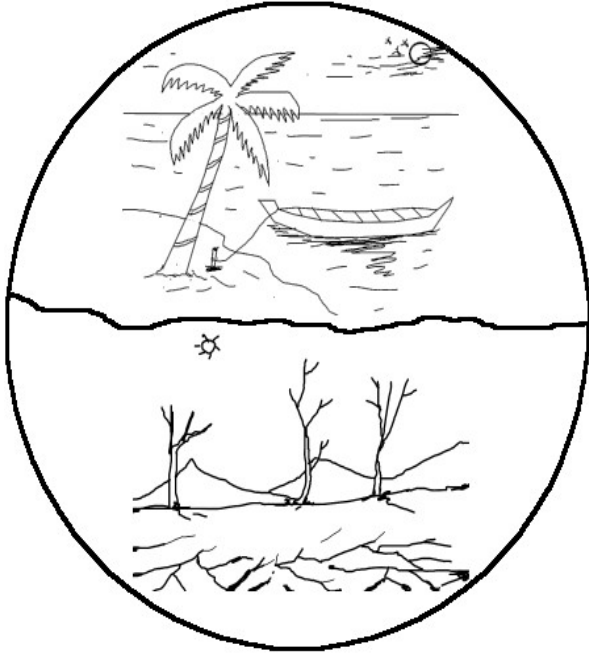
Ambition to man is what fragrance is to a flower . There may be flower without fragrance; but no man is without ambition.

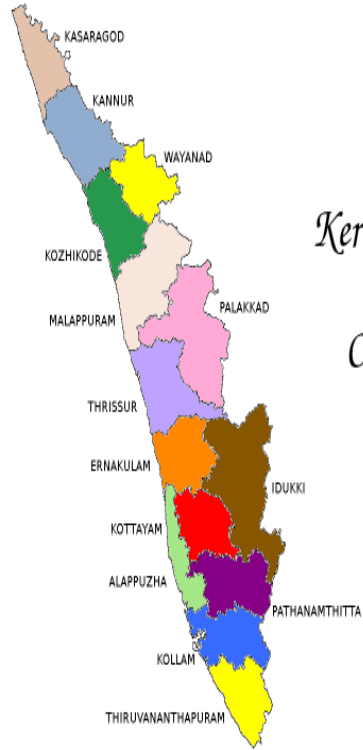
My Grandmother's House

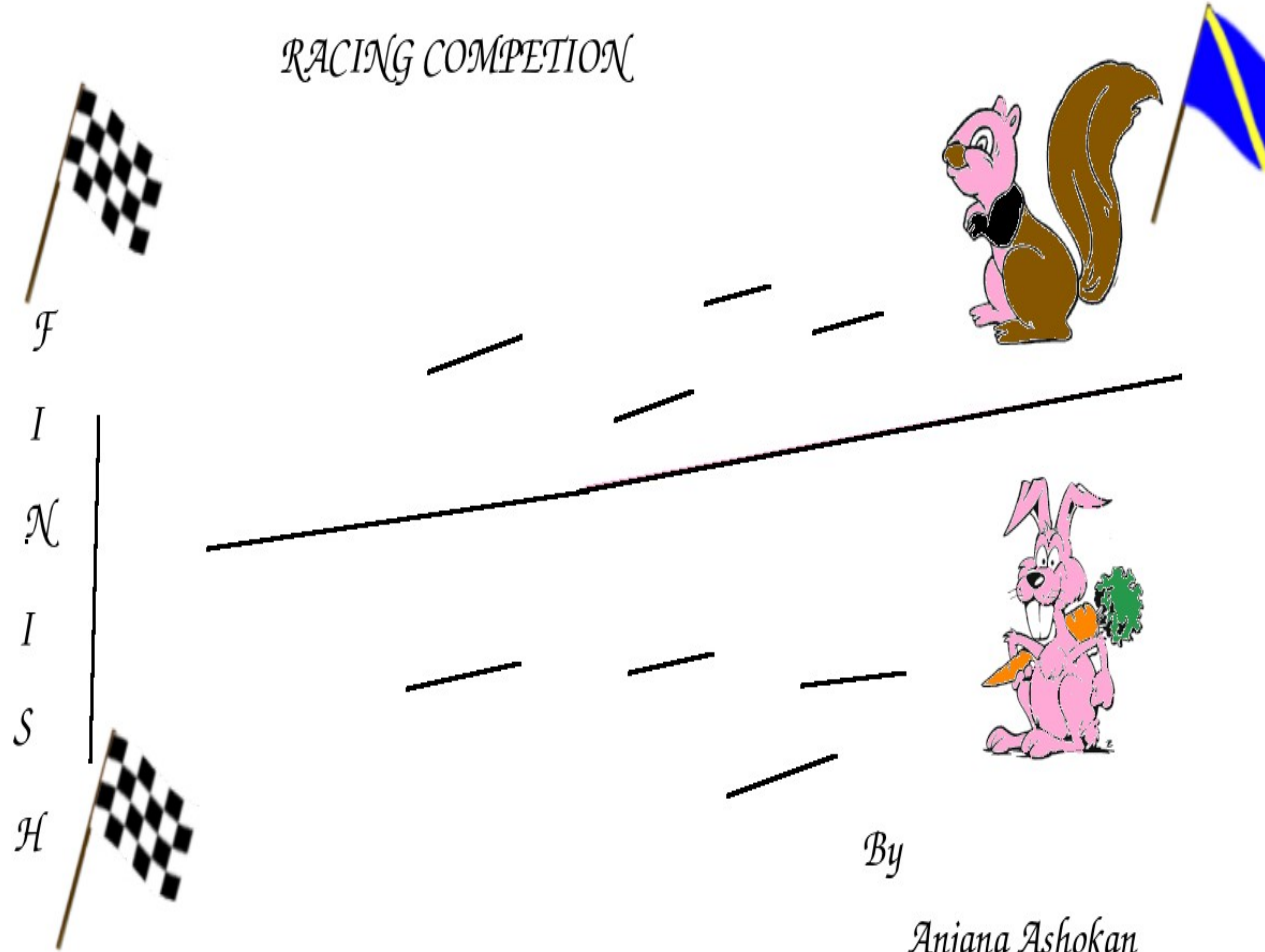
