Introduction

Government Junior Basic School Madhur, established on 5th November 1903, is located near the renowned Madhur Siddhivinayaka temple in the northern part of Kasaragod district. The school currently has students enrolled from pre-primary to Sourth grade, studying in both Malayalam and Kannada mediums. Most of the children speak Malayalam, Kannada, Tulu and Marathi.

A majority of the students belong to linguistic and minority communities that face economic and cultural disadvantages. To address these challenges, targeted activities have been incorporated into the school's academic master plan. As part of this initiative, teachers have planned specific classroom-level

activities to help students develop confidence and competence in using the English language. These activities aim to spark interest in English and enable children to use it with ease.

Additionally, hindi alphabets will be introduced to students of class 4. The activities are designed with the aim of developing different skills each month.
